	<p>Policy 42 Caravan, Camping and Chalet Development¹³⁹ ★</p> <p>New Caravan, Camping and Chalet sites and changes of accommodation pitch types within existing sites will be considered away from the coast and Preselis and in locations not <u>intervisible</u>¹⁴⁰ with them.</p> <p>Extensions to existing sites will be considered where the extension is in a well-screened location.</p> <p>Extensions to existing sites with no increase in pitch numbers to achieve clear environmental improvement in relation to landscaping and layout will be permitted where existing sites have highly prominent parts, often visible from the coast and inshore waters, and where extensions allow pitches to be transferred to more discreet locations.</p> <p>Proposals coming forward as set out above must ensure that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) New development (including ancillary facilities) and changes within sites avoid sensitive locations. New Criterion) and units are sited so that they can be readily assimilated into the landscape without causing an unacceptable adverse effect on the National Park landscape (see Policy 16). b) There are no unacceptable adverse cumulative effects when considered in conjunction with other development in the locality (see Policy 16). c) Any ancillary facilities should, wherever possible,
