Introduction

The performance report has been modified to follow the structure of the Corporate Plan for 2016/17. This follows the approach of the Well-being of Future Generations Act with seven well-being objectives, with an additional section providing general governance information.

The following report presents the performance to date up to 31st October. Some data sets relate only to the the first two quarters of the financial year 2016/17 (April - September.)

A number of data sets have been disaggregated to provide a more accurate reflection in these areas. This includes website hits data with information now provided on performance across the three separate sites. This has highlighted performance issues in terms of the number of hits to the Enjoy website. Staff are now considering the future direction and approach needed in terms of this site. Health and Safety incident categories have also been separated to reflect the different sorts of incidents recorded.


Please note data on SDF projects has been amended from approved projects to live projects to enable better analysis of contribution to the different Wellbeing Objectives within the Corporate Plan.




Centres Merchandise £ YTD (October)
