## National Development Framework

The National Development Framework is the highest tier of development plan in Wales and is focused on land use planning issues and challenges at a national scale. The purpose of the National Development Framework is to set out where Welsh Government considers Wales should grow and the types of development needed over the next twenty years to help Wales be a sustainable and prosperous society.

The National Development Framework will:

- set out where nationally important growth and infrastructure is needed and how the planning system - nationally, regionally and locally - can deliver it
- provide direction for Strategic and Local Development Plans and support the determination of Developments of National Significance
- sit alongside Planning Policy Wales, which sets out the Welsh Government's planning policies and will continue to provide the context for land use planning
- support national economic, transport, environmental, housing, energy and cultural strategies and ensure they can be delivered through the planning system

Officers will be responding to the consultation as part of the South West Wales Regional group by 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019. A series of drop in session have been

arranged by Welsh Government during the consultation period, which officers will utilise if necessary.
